TASTING NOTES:

Vinehouse is a blend, principally Cabernet Sauvignon with a bit of St. Macaire (lost Bordeaux varietal). Both are estate grown on Howell Mountain. The result of this historic marriage; a big luscious sexy wine with long legs of intensity on the palate, and incredible depth of color.

THE NOSE: Crushed blackberries, blueberries, and black currants.

ON THE PALATE: Classic crushed ripe blackberry, a whisper of creme de cassis, and a hint of licorice, graphite and underbrush.
